

MIDWIFERY

Midwifery programme graduates are prepared to provide **advice, care and support for women** and their families before, during and after delivery. They learn to carry out **monitoring and examination**, to take care of women and advise them during pregnancy, childbirth and puerperium. They learn **to assist during delivery** and to take care of **newborn children**. Part of their education is also gynaecological care of woman. They also learn how to provide preventive, medical, diagnostic, rehabilitative, urgent and dispensary care.

Specialized classrooms for midwives simulate delivery rooms. They are equipped with modern aids, models, tools and materials. Students learn on accurate anatomic models of mother and child and they learn to use modern obstetric tools and monitoring equipment.

Graduates receive education which is in accordance with World Health Organisation instructions and guidelines and with Ministry of Healthcare Resort Safety Objectives.
